Covid Precautions

Thank you to everyone who is wearing a mask and distancing at drop off and pick up time and to all the staff and children continuing to follow rigorous handwashing and ventilation during the school day. I know that some people feel we are still being over cautious but I am determined that every child should have as much time in



school as they can this year after the last two, and not miss 10 days at a time because of a covid case that could have been avoided because we had let up our guard.

Whilst classes are not closing for a single case, if we were to have an outbreak in a class or group then Public Health are still able to introduce additional measures to stop this notifiable disease. Those actions may include closing classes, mass testing or other actions that will impact on both staff and children.

Wearing a mask is one of the biggest precautions we can take to stop transmission which is why we are asking adults and older children to do this on site and when talking to school staff.
