

# SPORTING INFLUENCE

### Improving Social Skills Through Sport

This term, Mr McTernan has had great fun at Willow Tree on Tuesday mornings working with the children and teachers from two year groups.

Year 1 were first on the list and straight into PE sessions and made fabulous progress:

- Cherry class worked on Invasion Games and the principles of attack and defence. They used great communication to keep possession.
- Holly class showed off their net and wall skills as we looked at components that would help us play games like tennis, badminton and volleyball.
- Hornbeam class were creative gymnasts as they looked at putting together basic movements to create sequences.



Cherry class had lots of good ideas for our Invasion Games unit.

After half term, it was Year 5's turn:

- Elm class was introduced to Tag Rugby we learnt to ballcarry, tackle, pass and score tries
- Rowan class worked on their football skills keeping possession of the ball and thinking about team shape.
