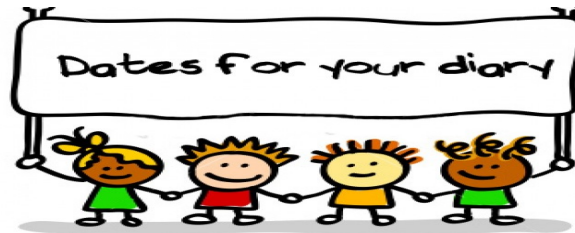

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Free School Meals



Are you entitled?

Are you eligible to apply for Income-Related Free School Meals?

Even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 (where meals are provided under the Infant School Meal programme), or if your child has a packed lunch, we ask that you still claim to ensure school receives the additional funding.

Did you know that School receives a significant amount of additional funding (Pupil Premium) per child registered as being in receipt of Free School Meals?

Children eligible for Free School Meals also receive subsidies for after school clubs, trips and residential visits (plus supermarket vouchers when these are offered as part of the Government's Covid Grant scheme).
