We are very excited to announce this year's School Council elections!

What does a School Council representative do?

"Members of the School Council will meet as a whole council once per half term and as a key stage once every two weeks. Members of the council will listen to their class' ideas and share these ideas at School Council meetings to make sure that everyone in school feels like their voice is heard. We will help to organise important events and improve our school for everyone!" - Miss Williams

If you would like to represent your class and become a member of this year's School Council, you will need to complete the <u>application process</u> as follows:

- . Write or draw why you would make a good School Council member. This should be given to your class teacher by the 3^{rd} November.
- . Make a short speech or a presentation to your class explaining why they should vote for you to be their School Council representative. Should you wish, you can make a short video presentation for your class to watch instead. If you would like to submit a video speech or presentation, please send these into admin@willowtree.n-yorks.sch.uk. Presentations will take place on the 3rd and 4th November.

Your speech/presentation should include:

- Your name
- Your class
- Why you would make a good member of the School Council
- How you will make sure your class feels their ideas are listened to

Classes will vote anonymously for their class School Council member. The person with the highest number of votes will become the School Council representative for your class!

This year there will be **ONE** member from each class that will be a sports crew member. You can put yourself forward for this role if you think you will be able to do the following:

Job specification-

Years 3 to 6 -

- Take the play time equipment outside and be responsible for bringing it back in.
- Start games at lunch time and break time.
- Help children to be active at break and lunch time.
- Be fair, listen to others and show respect.
- Know the rules of the games to be able to referee.
- Help sort out teams for games/sports at break and lunch time.
- Record any missing equipment to Mr Palmer and Mr Amstrong if they need to get it.
- Raise the aware of being active and set an example to others.
- Let Miss Percy, Miss Duncan or Miss Bucktrout know about any new ideas in the playground that could help the children in your class enjoy sports.
- Throughout the school day ensure that your class is aiming towards 60 minutes of exercise a day. This could be by introducing active time in your class: Maybe by doing jumping jacks for between each lesson or a 5 minute routine after lunch- it is completely up to you and the class teacher.

In addition, if you are in Year 5 —

- You will be the social media representative or photographer.
- The social media representative will sort out PE aspects for the newsletter and school twitter.
- The photographer will take pictures of any PE lessons, competitions or whole school events linked to PE.


In addition, if you are in Year 6 —
