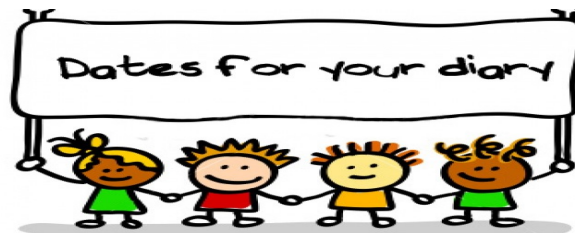

Xmas Dinner - Friday 10th December (watch this space for more details)

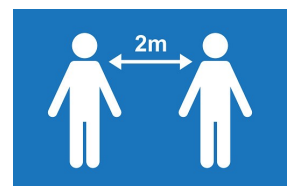
Break up - Friday 17th December (one hour earlier than their usual pick up time)

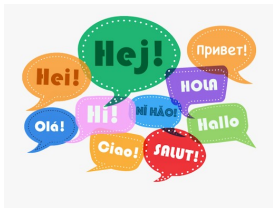
Travis in Rowan class took place in the remembrance parade in Starbeck on Sunday with Cubs.
